Releases

- Aluminum Release Notes still pending. Robert Varga made a suggestion for a Jira plugin so Luis Gomezor Anil Belur should be able to comment
 on that.
- Silicon Release Plans still pending
 - AAA, BGPCEP, NETCONF and LISP, need to come up with test plan
 - Neutron, NetVirt, Genius, ServiceUtils, OFP, and OVSDB plan to go to self-managed mode unless someone wants to take over the PTL and contribution roles. The teams will be around but will focus on downstream work.
 - Robert Varga has a set of in-flight patches for OFP & Genius that he feels should be merged.
 - The plan for these projects is to work on updates for major releases but not service releases.
 - Luis Gomez & Manoj Chokka say that we should spend a couple of weeks to check if there is anyone else who wants to keep them as managed projects.
 - Dependencies: ServiceUtils used by OFP, Neutron used by LISP Flow Mapping. There may be others.

Project Elections and TSC Structure

- Currently, the TSC elections are scheduled to begin 22 Oct 2020.
 A discussion ensued about changing the number of seats available on the TSC.
