  - Robert Varga has raised concerns about the Aluminum release. RESTCONF does not appear to be requiring authentication (the problem is in Netconf use of AAA API - see NETCONF-753). ...

  - Robert Varga we would like step-by-step documentation of what Anil Belur does to deploy the release so that the TSC and the
    community can gain more autonomy on this. We have concerns about his responsiveness and would like to know if there is something
    that we can do as a community.
